State DOT Paving Schedule

The State DOT will be very active with road paving projects in Cheshire this year. Residents have likely seen catch basin and intersection work performed along these associated state roads over the past few weeks. The State plans to pave the entire remaining length of Route 10 from N. Brooksvale Rd to Stoney Hill Rd (Cheshire Park) as well as Route 70/Waterbury Rd from the Waterbury line to Old Waterbury Rd/High View Terrace and the Commuter Lot off I-84. The work will be done at night and is tentatively scheduled to begin August 21st and conclude in mid-September.



Street Sweeping Program

Cheshire DPW began their annual street sweeping operations earlier this month and will be making their way throughout town, wrapping up by mid-June.

Street sweeping begins in the southwest quadrant of town and will be progressing counterclockwise, ending in the northwest quadrant.



2024 Neighborhood Assistance Applications – Due June 3, 2024

The Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act (NAA) Tax Credit Program is designed to provide funding for municipal and tax-exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses who make cash contributions to these entities. Each municipal agency or tax-exempt organization that wishes to participate in the NAA Program must complete in its entirety Form NAA-01. Applications are due by Friday, June 3, 2024 and must be submitted directly to the Town Manager’s Office, 84 South Main St., Cheshire, CT 06410. Interested organizations wishing to learn more about the program and/or have specific questions should visit the State of Connecticut Department of Revenue Services website as the Town’s role is primarily administrative.

Applications are approved by the municipality’s governing body and forwarded to Department of Revenue Services (DRS). Once an organization is approved by the state, businesses can receive a credit of 60% of their approved contribution to certain programs (or 100% in the case of certain energy conservation programs) approved by the DRS.

Recreation Updates

- We've reached a very exciting milestone for the Bartlem Park South project, as of tomorrow, Wednesday, April 17th the new turf field will be officially opened for use. The Town has accepted ownership of this portion of the project and construction fencing has been moved to the south and west perimeter of the field to maintain safety from the rest of the active construction site. Initially the field will only be available to Cheshire Youth Lacrosse and the CHS Lacrosse programs and is not open for general public use at this time. The lights will not be available until the bathroom building and Eversource hookups are completed later in the summer.
